

OUR SCHOOL'S FINANCIAL NEEDS



As increasing funding cuts and grant reductions impact state schools, our school has set the following **fundraising priorities** to support our pupils.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

Provision of after school clubs and activities to rebuild pupil confidence and wellbeing, allowing vital opportunities for socialising and relationship building.



COST: £40 PER CHILD PER WEEK

SCHOOL JOURNEY



A 5-day outdoor activity and camping programme for year 5 children at the end of the summer term. We want all our pupils to be able to attend this important week, regardless of their economic situation.

COST: £200 PER CHILD


LIBRARY BOOKS

Our Federation is in need of new literature including curriculum texts and, vitally, a more diverse range of books. We are focussed on diversifying our books and curriculum.

COST: £4,000 (£3,000 FOR BAME BOOKS)



BREAKFAST CLUB



We no longer receive sufficient government funding to provide breakfast for our pupils. Breakfast club ensures that all children who need it, receive a meal at the beginning of the school day.

COST: £1,500 PER ANNUM


DEVICES FOR FAMILIES

To support remote learning we need to purchase electronic devices for families who have limited or no access to technology. Less advantaged pupils should not have to fall further behind.

COST: £300 PER FAMILY

Our ball court is currently made of concrete which causes lots of bruises and scratches when children fall. A new play surface will allow us to play a greater range of sports and games

COST: £25,000
